














PRITAM SINGH MEMORIAL (PRISM) CONFERENCE

November 17-19, 2022




A once-in-a-hundred-year flood is uncommon, yet flooding does occur at some point in time. During the flood, life changes dramatically from what it was before. The COVID-19 pandemic is an example of a once-in-a-hundred-year flood that has had a tremendous impact on both the economic and social aspects of business. Few industries like information technology, pharmaceuticals, health care diagnostics, e-commerce, education technology benefitted from the crisis, while others like aviation and hospitality faced unseen challenges. As the world entered the year 2022, the reality of a COVID -19 world became further embedded. Work from home, digitization, automation, and AI have altered management functions.

The theme of the first PRISM conference "Architecting the future of business - leadership, governance and technology" attempted to capture the struggle of leaders and managers trying to reinvent and redefine businesses to navigate this emerging reality. In keeping with its vision, the theme of the second PRISM conference, "Leading the business of the future: Talent, technology, and transformation in a changing world," seeks to investigate the changes in people, processes, and technology that organizations must make in order to thrive in a post-pandemic world.

Conceived under the broad thematic umbrella of business agility and resilience, the second edition of PRISM, brings together a mix of academics and practitioners for panel discussions and keynote addresses that provide diverse perspectives on balancing the need for sustainability and agility in complex business environments. Sustainability is not just a buzzword. It is a way of life and it should be embedded in every aspect of business. Sustainability has become more than an environmental issue - it has become a business imperative encapsulating the role of people, processes and technology. With diversity in teams, sustainability can be achieved by focusing on the environment and human rights, and making sure that everyone has equal access to opportunities. Technologies such as Big Data, cloud computing, artificial intelligence (AI) and robotics have the potential to help us achieve both environmental and social sustainability goals such as reducing emissions, improving worker conditions and ushering a new era of human-machine collaboration that improves societal well-being.

With these concerns in mind and the values ingrained by Dr. Pritam Singh, the second edition of PRISM intends to pave the way for sincere deliberation on the future of our nation by bringing together scholars, practitioners, academics, and thought-leaders from various walks of life.



ABOUT PADMA SHRI DR. PRITAM SINGH



Dr. Pritam Singh is widely regarded as a business education trailblazer whose efforts transformed both public and private management education in India. Dr. Singh was an institution builder who oversaw prestigious institues such as IIM Lucknow and was instrumental in the creation of B-schools such as IMI Delhi and MDI Gurgaon, which helped set new standards in private management education in India. Dr. Singh, a visionary thinker with strong convictions, introduced Indian business schools to international accreditations and pioneered various executive education programs in Indian business schools during his stint as Director.

Dr. Pritam Singh's charisma extended beyond the classroom, having acted as an advisor to more than 200 CEOs from India and throughout the world on a wide range of business issues. As a member of over 20 corporate boards, he conducted over 100 retreats for the top management of private and public sector organizations, multi-national corporations, enterprise board members, and Vice Chancellors and Deans of Indian Universities to strengthen their governance. Dr. Singh also wrote ten highly regarded academic books (three of which have won awards) and published over 50 research papers. Dr. Singh was a sought-after global speaker who addressed a variety of Indian and global audiences.

He was conferred with the Padma Shri in 2004 for his contributions towards management education, a first for a professor and a serving Director in India. He received more than a dozen prestigious national level awards. MIRBIS - the leading management school in Moscow honoured him with the 9th 'GLOBAL THOUGHTLEADER' award 2006 - 2007, making him the first Asian to be receive such an honor.



This conference was organized on the theme, "Architecting the Future of Business - Leadership, Governance and Technology". It had an impressive line-up of speakers, with international speakers from Australia, Japan, France, Singapore, UK, and USA. The who's who of the Indian industry and banking sector shared their views and insights with the participants - stakeholders from academia, industry, regulators, policymakers, and the technology industry.

The PRISM conference will be an annual offering of the Foundation. It will be conducted in partnership with different management schools every year to celebrate the birth anniversary of Dr. Pritam Singh on 19th of November.

The Foundation organized competitions with generous prizes for toppers in three domains:

- Competition for faculty of management schools Best Research paper.
- Competition for the Best Case for young managers from the corporate sector.
- Best-case solution competition for B School students.

These are annual competitions conducted along with the annual PRISM conference.

Future plans: A Mentoring initiative will be shortly launched by the PRISM Foundation, led by leading stalwarts from the industry.


