- Total Number of Students: The PGP Batch of 2021-23 is comprised of 258 students.
- Gender Diversity: Percentage of Female candidates is 23%.
- Average Age: The average age of the students, who hail from more than 20 states, is 24 years.
- Freshers Vs Work Ex Candidates: Fresh graduates constitute 37% of the batch, which has an average work experience of 17 months.
- Non Engineers: This IIMN batch has the highest proportion of non-engineers 21% till date.
- Academic & Professional Experiences: IIMN batch is quite diverse, with experienced workers from
 consulting, hospitality, pharmaceuticals and healthcare, banking, financial services, fashion marketplace
 services, EdTech, political consultancy, forensic and integrity services, chartered accountants and
