2. Supply installation and commissioning LOT type gas bank system.
3. Providing of Free service and maintenance of both gas banks for 1 year from date of completion of work (Labor and Visiting Charges will be free of cost). Charges of Consumables will be paid extra by IIMN.

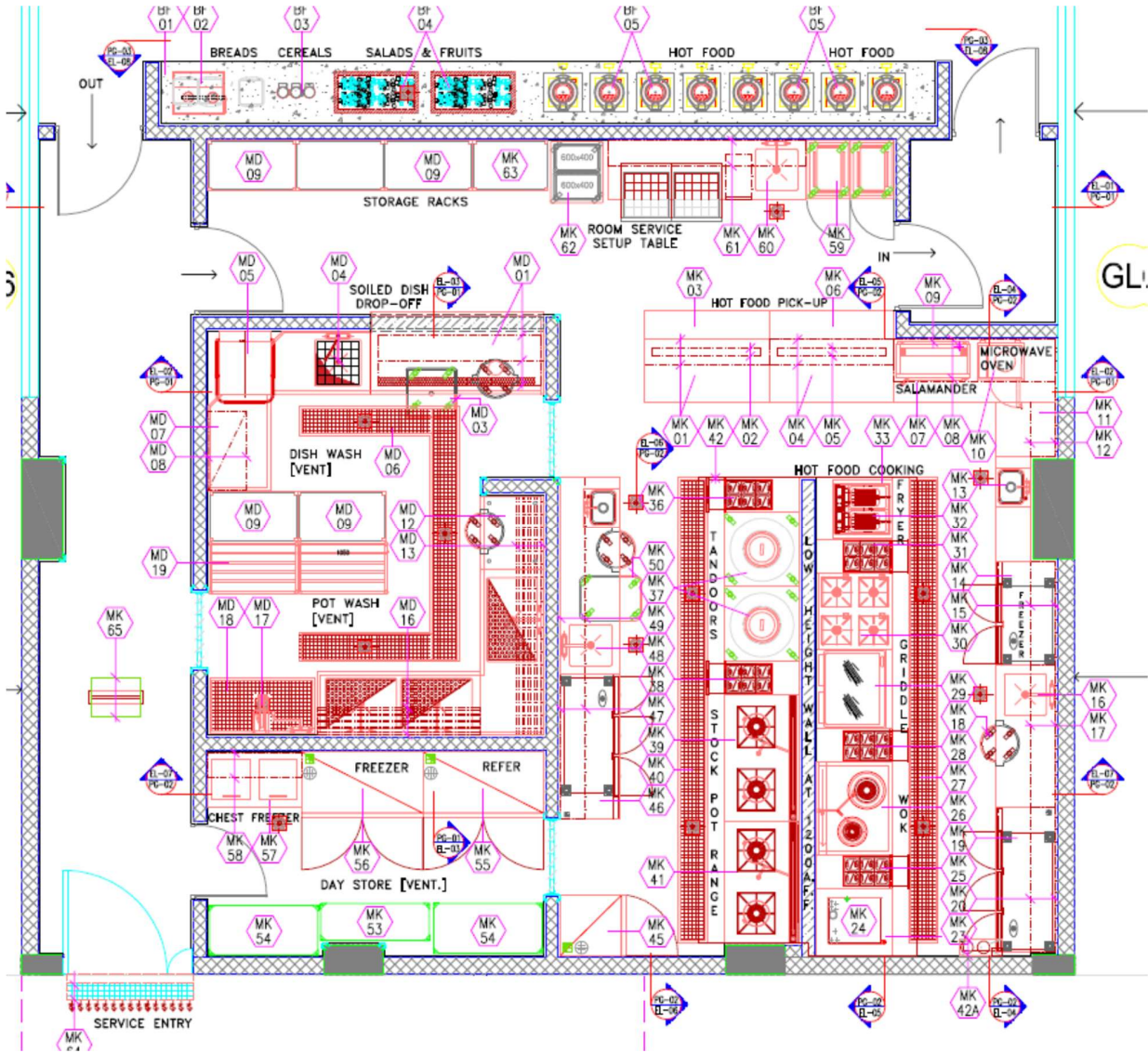

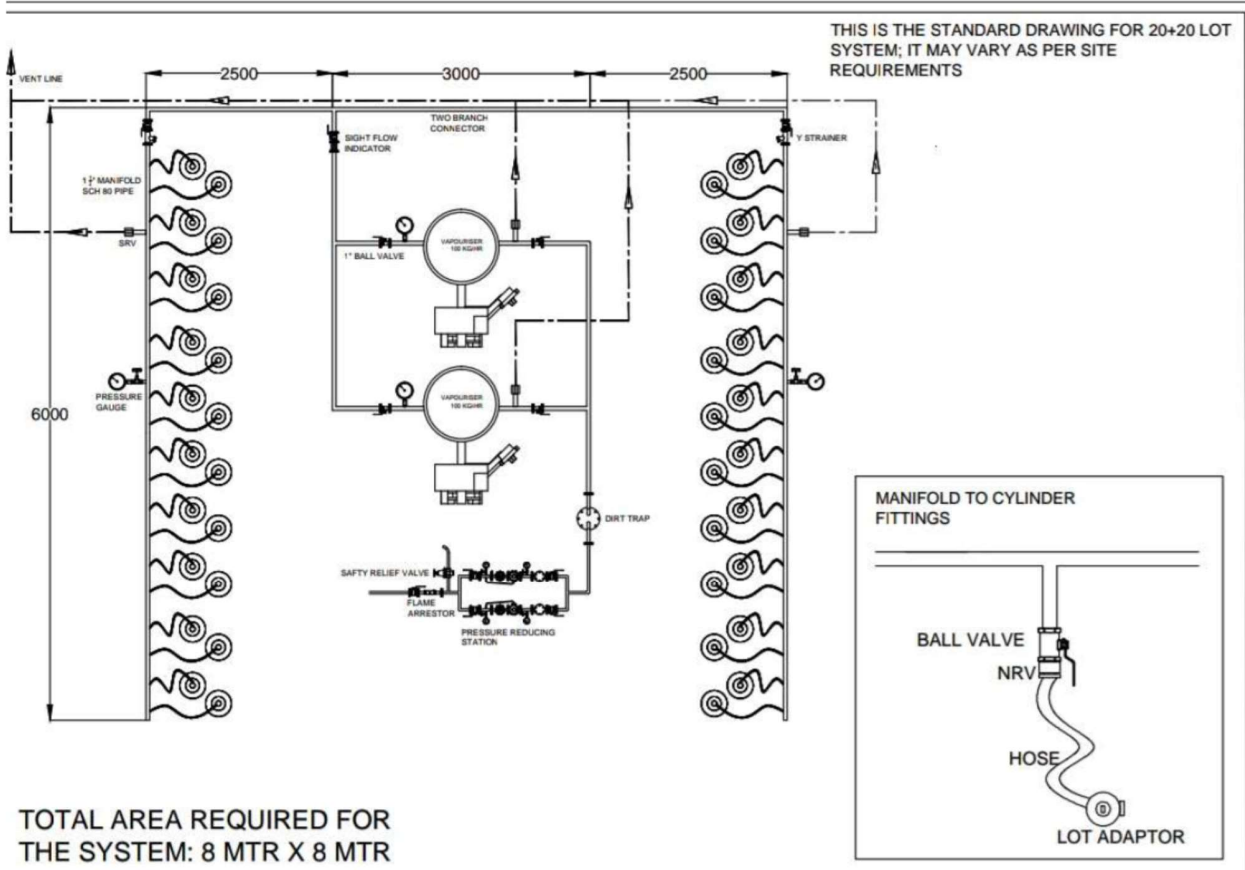


Kitchen Layout of EEP Dining block for which work is to be done (To be checked Physically by Bidder before Bidding)



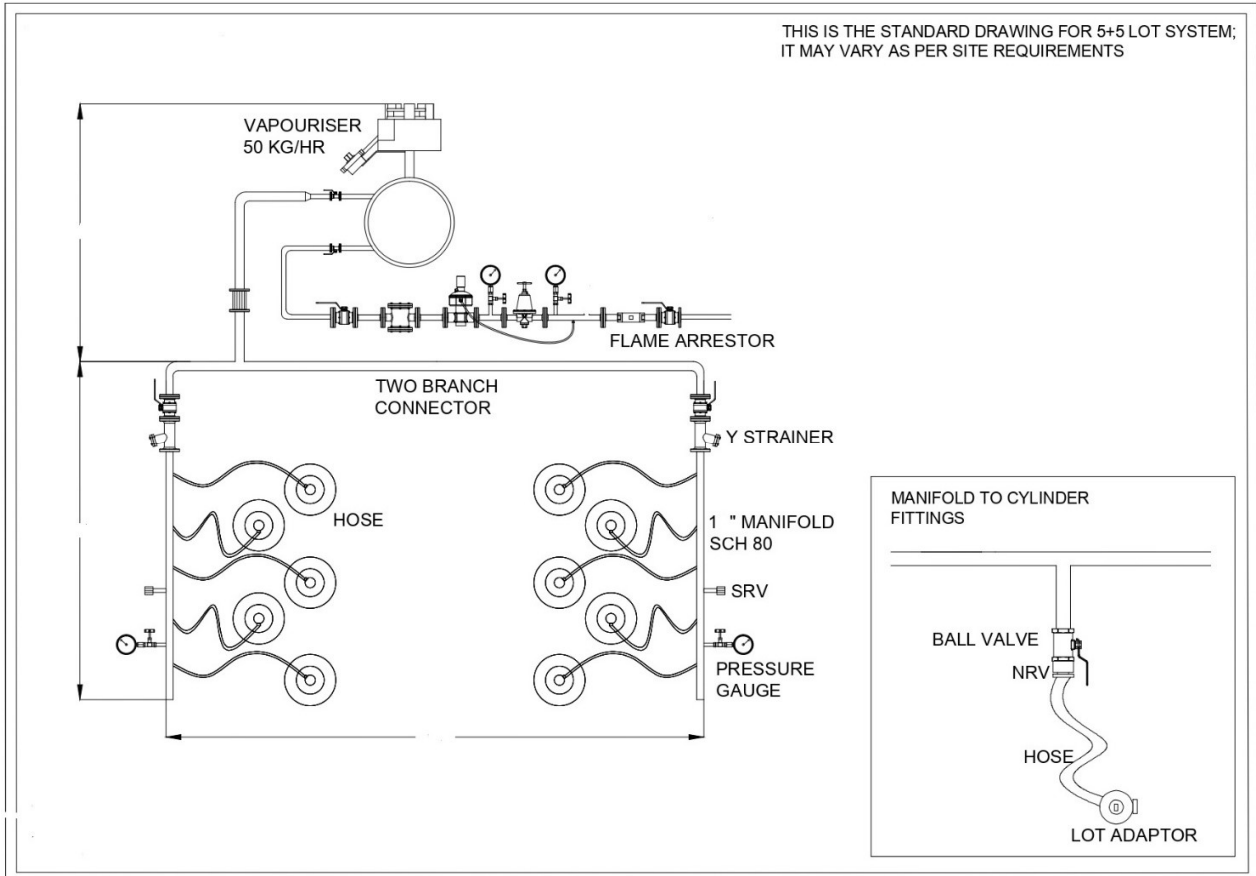


Indicative Layout of Gas bank for S& F Dining Block (Bidders have to submit their own layout proposal and drawings)
