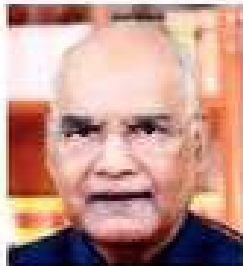


Administration on high alert for President's visit
