2. Measures taken to complete the syllabus of courses and programs.	<p>Measures taken to complete the syllabus of courses and programs at IIM Nagpur. IIM Nagpur seamlessly transitioned into online-mode of teaching during the pandemic. The head of the programme met with student community at regular intervals to assess issues leading to learning gaps. Additionally, inputs regarding in-class learning in online mode were considered from faculty. There was no apparent loss of learning due to the pandemic. All IIM Nagpur students already had smartphones/tablets/laptops for attending classes. The students were notified in advance to arrange a good internet connection/broadband. Nevertheless, while selecting online teaching tools, importance was given to the tools which could operate on lower internet bandwidth. Also, the ability to watch class recordings later have mitigated the impact of poor internet speed. There were few students who were facing the internet connectivity issue, those students were given chance to come back to campus in a phased manner (following the rules and regulation of covid-19 as set by the government) and use the institutes Wi-Fi for attending online classes. Institute has been sending the hard copies of the course textbooks to each student in an appropriate time before the start of respective terms. Moreover, additional course related reading material were made available on LMS (Moodle Learning Management System) software from where the students could easily download the reading material. Staff from Programme office were in constant touch with the student representatives to resolve queries pertaining to academic activities. Also, interim meetings were conducted by the Programme head to understand and resolve online learning difficulties faced by students. Moreover, all students have access to e-library comprising of e-journals, E-books, E-databases, E-newspapers. A training workshop was conducted to help students use e-library in an effective manner. Staff from library was in touch with the students for any queries/troubleshoot. Multiple steps were taken to ensure effective online teaching. The following points highlight major steps:</p> <p>1. A faculty workshop was organised by IIM Nagpur to share pedagogy issues pertaining to online teaching. The workshop was conducted by a faculty who had rich experience of conducting MOOCs (Massive Open Online Courses) in the past. This workshop helped faculty members in planning online classes effectively by using better technological/software tools to improve the in-class interaction. 2. Multiple Demo sessions were conducted to make faculty members comfortable with online mode of teaching. 3. Detailed SOPs on technical aspects of online teaching were provided to all faculty members. 4. Technological infrastructure of classrooms was improved drastically in short timeline to help faculty members in smooth delivery of online classes. Multiple engagement tools were used during and beyond class hours to improve the effectiveness of the online learning. IIM Nagpur has used the existing LMS (Moodle-Learning Management System) software to assist in structured learning. This LMS has become the one place for all course related activities (online class, course material, readings, post-class discussion). Apart from this, our faculty members have used innovative ways to effectively enhance the learning experience.</p> <p>IIMN prepared itself for teaching in modes other than face to face teaching through various demos of different service providers. At present the SOPs offering online classes/courses are in place and the same may be used in future, adapting to necessary requirements as the situation evolves</p>
