Crisis of different types, at various times, have always kept the world's affairs uncertain, said member of the Economic Advisory Council to the Prime Minister (EAC-PM), Sanjeev Sanyal while addressing MBA students at IIM Nagpur on Monday afternoon. He was speaking on 'Policymaking in uncertain times.'

during the question-answer session held on the occasion. While commenting on the effects of the one-child policy adopted by China, Mr. Sanyal said it was a very bad idea as it led to a catalytic decline in their population. One child means a 50 percent decline in

population in one generation, which is not a minor shift.
